## Marking the summary:

The summary should be marked as follows:

- **Mark allocation:**
  - 7 marks for 7 facts (1 mark per main point).
  - 3 marks for language.
  - Total marks: 10

- **Distribution of language marks:**
  - 3 facts (1 language mark)
  - 5 facts (2 language marks)
  - 7 facts (3 language marks)

- **Indicate verbatim quotes:**

- NB {
- 1 – 5 quotes, award only 1 mark for language.
  - 5 – 7 quotes, award 0 for language.

## NOTE:

- **Format:**

Even if the summary is presented in the incorrect format, it must be assessed. The points should be clear enough for the marker to understand the meaning.
- **Word count:**
  - Markers are required to verify the number of words used.
  - Do not deduct any marks if the candidate fails to indicate the number of words used or if the number of words used is indicated incorrectly.
  - If the word limit is exceeded, read up to a maximum of 75 words above the stipulated upper limit and ignore the rest of the summary.
  - Summaries that are short, but contain all the required main points, **should not** be penalised.

**NOTE:** Even though the use of abbreviations is not encouraged, they must be counted as complete words and the word count represented accordingly.
