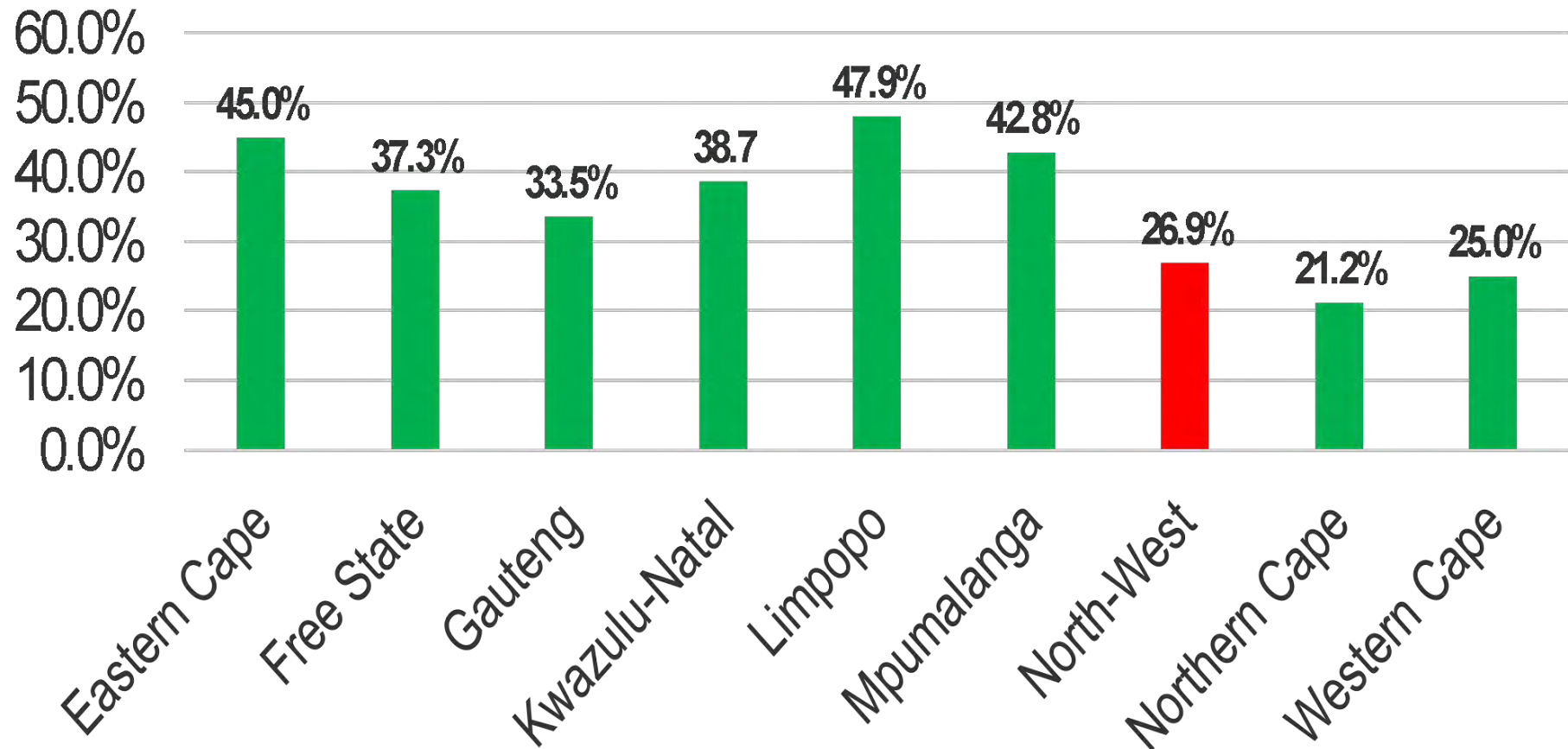
DBE Vs NW % MATHS ACHIEVED



DBE vs NW %PHY. SC ACHIEVED

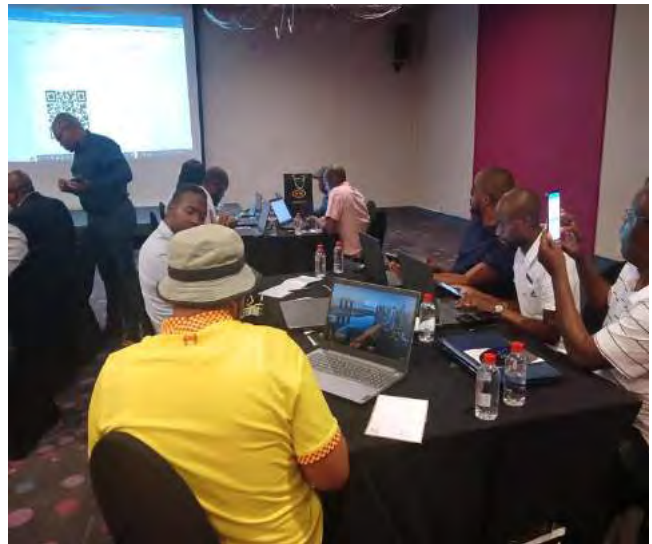

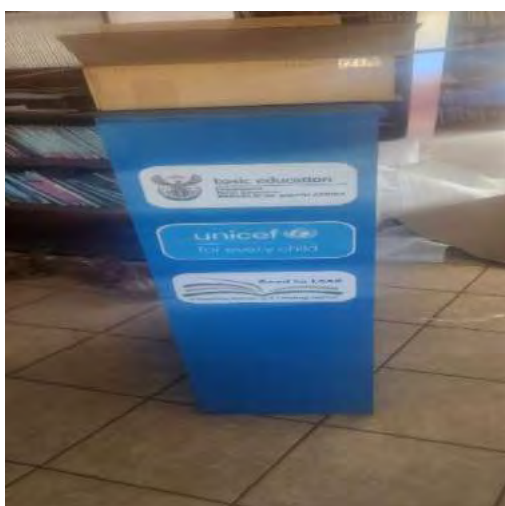

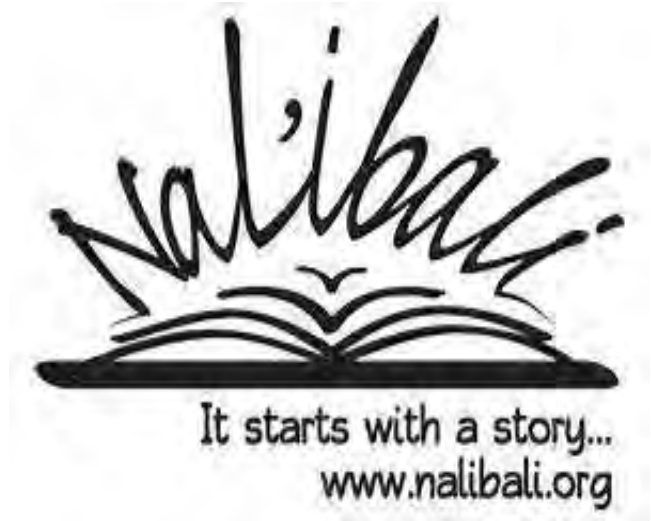

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2024 line of direction

- The performance target for 2024 is 90%, a difference of 9% from the 2023 output
- The current cohort is 5% weaker than the 2023 class in overall performance of Grade 11.
- Still the key high enrolled subjects are among the identified under-performing subjects.
- This calls for intense, more focused form of support to the learners.

Challenges for attaining 90%

- Lack of equipment's for online assistance
- Inadequate teacher training/ Direct Learner support on content deficiencies (CAMPS)
- Timeous communication between officials and schools
- Lack of foundations skills in FET feeder subjects in Grade 8& 9

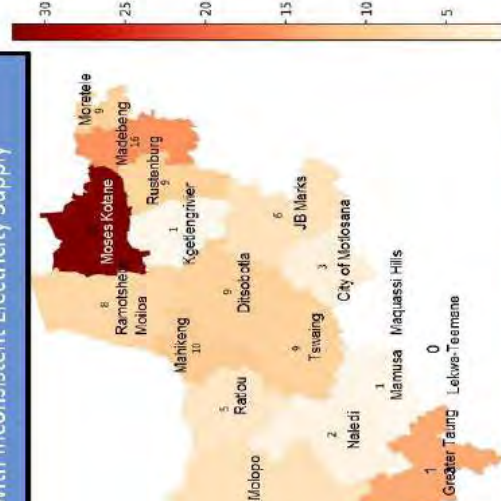

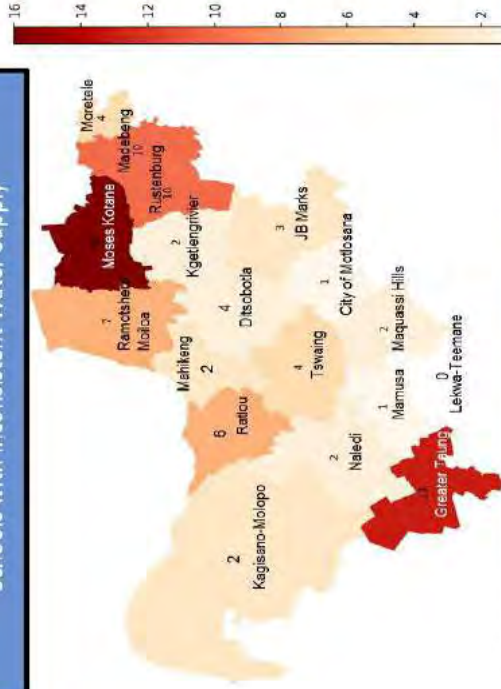

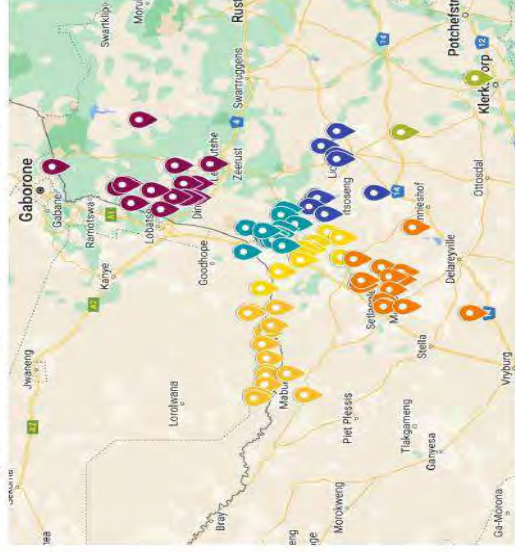

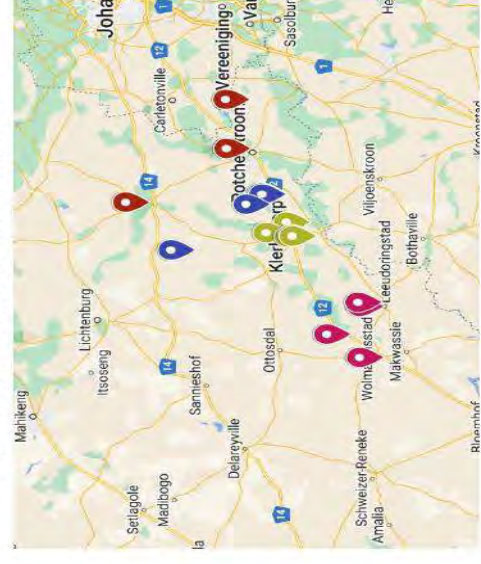
Bojanala Clusters

 - Maintenance (920 schools – R 5.8 billion at 6 million per school)
 - New classrooms (1145 Classrooms – R 1.1 billion)
 - Grade R classrooms (826 grade R classrooms – R 620 million)
 - Fencing (255 schools – R 384 million)
